OFFICE ORDER

In pursuance of the directions issued by the Government of Assam, Mission Directorate, Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban), Assam vide Notification regarding implementation of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026, and in the interest of maintaining cleanliness, public health, and environmental protection within the jurisdiction of Sorbhog Municipal Board, it is hereby ordered that all individuals, households, commercial establishments, institutions, offices, shops, markets, hotels, restaurants, educational institutions, healthcare facilities, and all other waste generators shall strictly comply with the provisions of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026 with immediate effect.

The following directions shall be mandatorily followed by all concerned:

1. All waste generators shall ensure source segregation of waste into four categories, namely:

- Wet Waste
- Dry Waste
- Sanitary Waste
- Special Care Waste

2. Mixed waste disposal shall not be permitted under any circumstances.

3. Households, commercial establishments, and institutions shall hand over segregated waste only to the authorized waste collection vehicles/workers of the Municipal Board.

4. Bulk Waste Generators including hotels, hostels, apartments, marriage halls, institutions, markets, and commercial establishments shall make necessary arrangements for processing of wet waste within their premises or comply with the directions issued by the competent authority.

5. Littering, open dumping, burning of waste, disposal of waste into drains, water bodies, roadsides, or public places is strictly prohibited.

6. All citizens and establishments shall cooperate with the Municipal Board officials, ward representatives, and designated nodal officers for implementation of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026.

7. Self Help Group (SHG) members engaged by the Municipal Board shall assist in awareness activities, source segregation, door-to-door monitoring, sanitation drives, and implementation of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026.

8. Non-compliance of the above directions shall attract penalties, environmental compensation, and other legal action as per the provisions of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026 and other applicable laws.

9. Further, for effective implementation, monitoring, awareness generation, and coordination of Solid Waste Management activities under the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026, the following Nodal Officers are hereby appointed ward-wise within the jurisdiction of Sorbhog Municipal Board:



- Babita Bania – Ward No. 4, 5, 7 & 9
- Nirmal Das – Ward No. 1, 2 & 10
- Dhiraj Kumar Das – Ward No. 3, 6 & 8

The above-mentioned Nodal Officers shall coordinate with Ward Commissioners, sanitary staff, SHG members, and field functionaries for ensuring proper segregation, collection, monitoring, awareness activities, grievance redressal, and enforcement of the provisions of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026 within their respective wards.

All Ward Commissioners, sanitary staff, and concerned officials of Sorbhog Municipal Board are directed to ensure proper awareness, monitoring, and enforcement of the above instructions within their respective jurisdictions.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force until further orders.
